

# KNOW YOUR PRODUCTS

Which products work best for dealing with bacteria?

## DETERGENT



Start by using a detergent to wash surfaces; for example washing up liquid or laundry powder. Detergents don't kill bacteria but they do clean things. Detergents break down grease and dirt which can harbour bacteria.

## DISINFECTANT



Disinfectant is a substance that kills germs on non-living things. The most common type of household disinfectant is bleach.

(Bleach is corrosive and should be used with care)

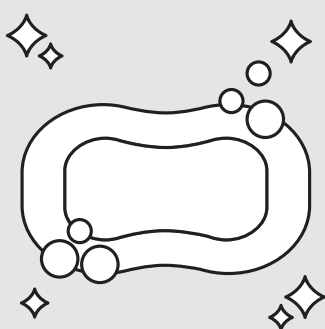
## BIOLOGICAL CLEANERS



BIOLOGICAL CLEANERS are eco-friendly alternatives to bleach. They contain 'good bacteria' that work by consuming 'bad bacteria' and keep surfaces cleaner for longer.

## ANTIBACTERIAL CLEANERS



Antibacterial products kill, or at least reduce, the number of harmful germs and bacteria lurking in homes

## ANTISEPTICS



Antiseptics are substances that kill germs on living things. They do a similar job to disinfectants, but they are for people rather than floors, surfaces and other inanimate objects.

## SANITISERS



Sanitisers are products that both break down dirt AND attack bacteria.
